To Whom It May Concern,

Bloomington Elementary has a carry over of funds from last year in the amount of \$30,000. Some of these funds came from a reduction in the price that we pay for our BTS music teacher. We would like to use the additional money in the following ways:

1. \$3,000 to be put towards hiring subs for our teachers to be able to go on learning walks and meet in teams for data meetings.
2. \$27,000 to be put towards buying additional Chromebooks for classrooms.
 - a. Our class sizes are larger this year and we need more Chromebooks to accommodate the student numbers
 - b. We are on a computer rotation of replacing outdated Chromebooks for classrooms.

These extra funds will help support our TSSA/Trustland PEERS Goal #1 which states that 80% of student will make typical or above growth this year in reading and 70% growth in math instruction. The technology money will support this goal by giving us more Chromebooks for students to do ST Math and Lexia programs on. The sub funds will be used to help teachers be able to have data meetings and watch each other teach highly effective lessons to improve instruction in reading and math.


