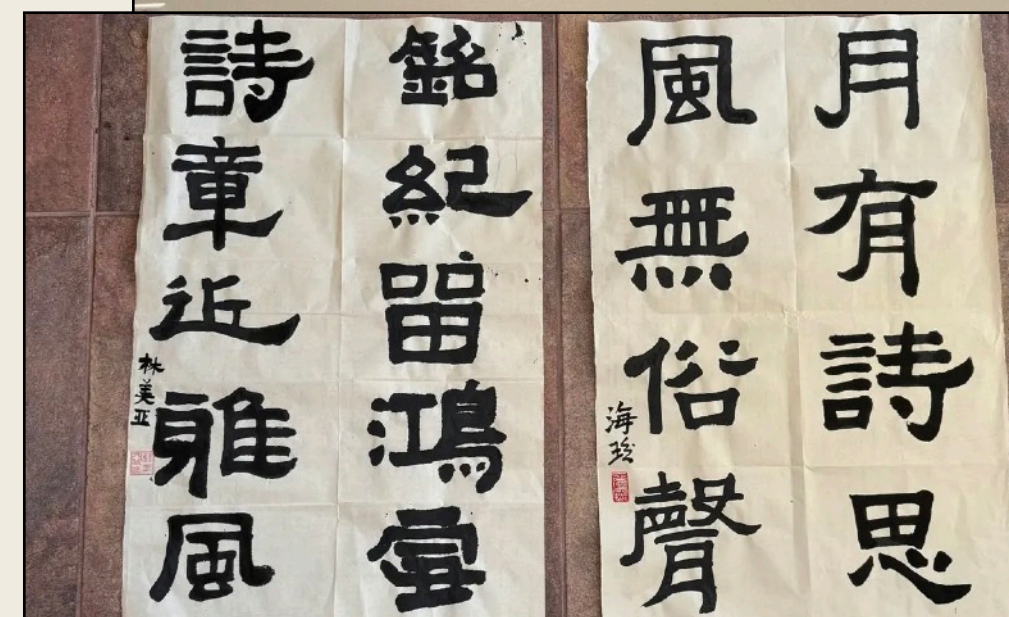
Council Data

- 6 current members, with 2 new members starting this month
 - 12 events in FY2023
 - Between 6,000-7,000 people participated in our events in FY2023
 - Installed the first permanent art structure in the city in October 2022
 - Preapproved for an increase in our ZAP grant by \$2,000 for upcoming fiscal year

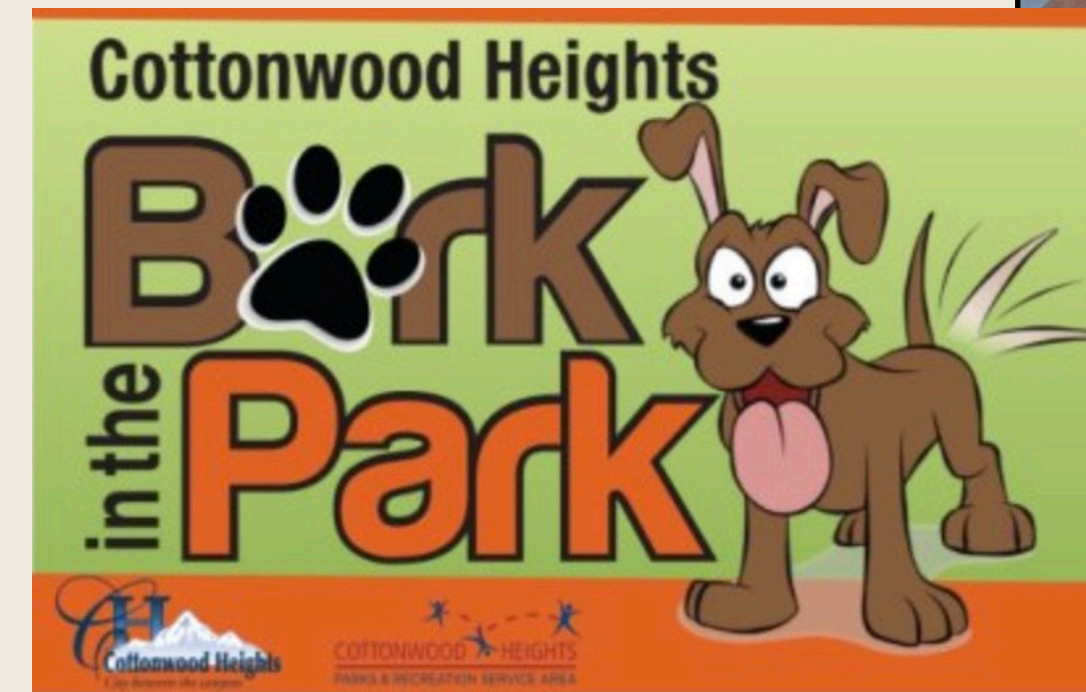

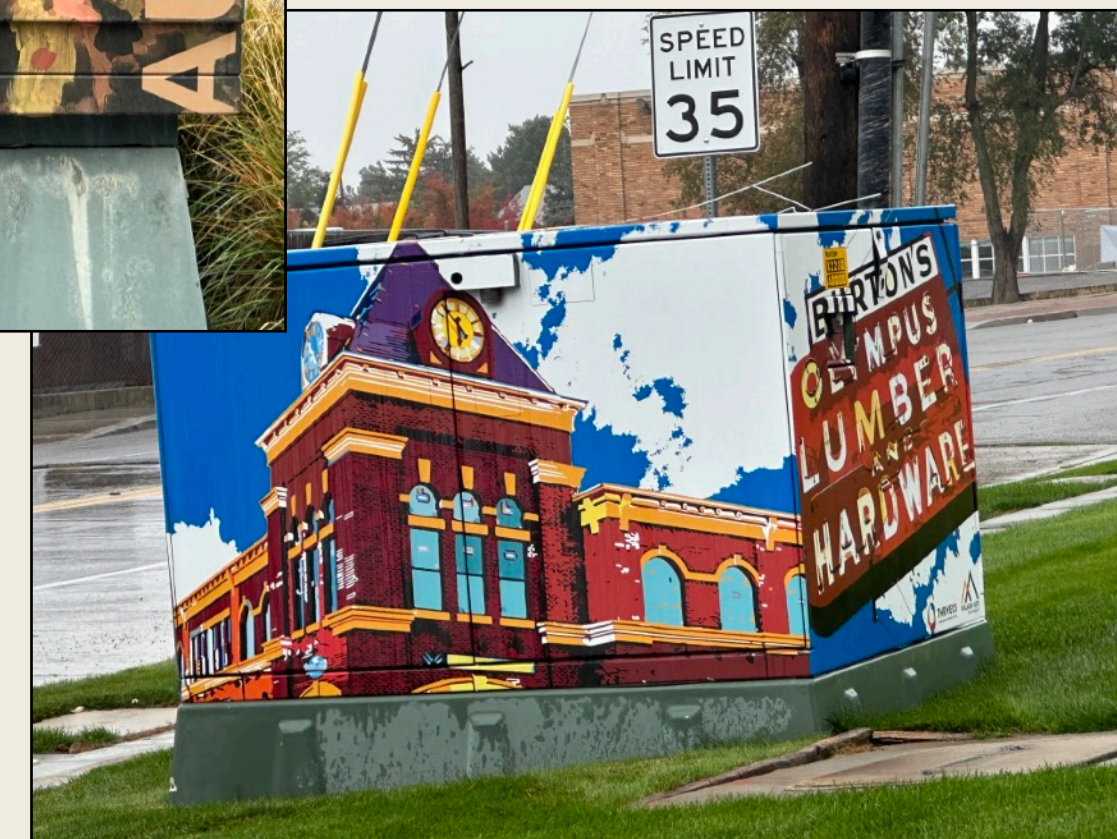
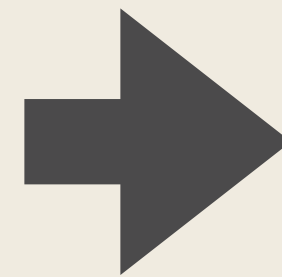
