Approval of Minutes:

- Kaycee made a motion to approve the minutes from the May Golf Advisory Board Meeting. Seth seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as written.

Finance Report:

- Dawn and Jeff went over the financial report.
- Total revenue for almost every category is up for the year.
- Reminder for reading financial report: under payments (punch cards) when the city does its accounting it recognizes punch pass sales for the month they are sold.
- Numbers look great considering the late spring start and flooding this year.

Update on #14-15 Cart Path Report:

- Was all engineered and out for bid. Presented to 3 contractors, no one took the bid.
- Randy has reached out to the Country Club for other options such as concrete instead of a blacktop surface.
- Concrete would work better overall.

Update on Spring Flood Damage Recovery:

- Permit application for river alteration has been submitted.
- Schedule for Golf Course portion needs to be done before the next spring run-off.

Update on Driving Range Improvements:

- Russ let board members know there is currently \$50,000 in the budget for Golf Course improvements.
- Permanent tee pads on the range are one of the items funds will be used for.
- Each time Capital resources are given, improvements to the course should be made due to high demand and use of course.
- Rick asked if there was a timetable for this project. Randy said it could be done in the winter. Off-season would be best for improvements.

Women's Association Report:

- Linzie let everyone know closing social is coming up.
- About 40% of association plays in structured events but are playing more weekly.
- The women's team play has won again for the third time.

Men's Association Report:

- Closer is Saturday.
- A few more weeks of regular play, then will slow down for the season.
- 3-man scramble is in October.

Golf Superintendent Report:

- Pulled up drone video of course to show board members.
- Has fertilized over 100 acres.

Golf Professional Report:

- Jeff let board members know the Golf Course needs help, building needs attention, needs more staffing.
- Tom asked if Mike Miller, being over facilities, could help with building maintenance at the Pro Shop.
- Russ let him know he can only help to an extent as the divisions are in different budgets and can get tricky.
- Board members discussed much needed improvements and what the board can do to help facilitate action.
- Schreibers, Pepsi, Farm Bureau, Top Job and Poulsen have all signed sponsorship contracts.
- Website with sponsors is currently not working.
