They have a big project that they are going to work on. It is on the East side of the trail. They had some reconstruction from a vehicle washing out. They also have wear from the equestrians going up and down right there they're wearing the trail out and They have lost about 3 feet of trail access. They are going to have to block that trail from horses as well as hiking, because they're going to put in some road based big blocks. and kind of make it almost a step-in order to keep those nine feet for emergency vehicles that need that cross through there, which is a larger project, but they wanted to let you know that 1 of those trails will be Closed.

Parks have been up there quite a bit this last month. Taking out dead trees. Trimming bushes, getting the trail cleared up. You may notice piles on the side of the trail. They plan on coming back to pick those up. The rain has delayed heavy equipment getting up the trail. The chip trail will only be blocked for a day or possibly 2. Then basically just that 1 little access point for a single track or horse trail that will be blocked.
