Approval of the May 17, 2012 Minutes

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Reorganization of Classroom Hours
Online Training

Mr. Rose presented proposed rule changes regarding the existing training requirements. Mr. Rose had concerns about the 24 hours being used entirely for basic training due to the fact that it cripples many of the Security companies especially in the rural areas. Mr. Rose suggested that 16 hours could remain as core required training with the remaining eight hours used as elective training. Mr. Rose suggested the elective hours could include items such as on-line training, CPR/first aid, and individual home work assignments.

Mr. Beckstead seconded by Mr. Sheets made a motion to accept at least 16 hours as core training as outlined in the handout and eight hours of elective training.

Ms. Ellis stated she would draft a rule and e-mail it out to the Committee as well as present it before the Security Board scheduled in February.

Training Programs

The Committee had concerns about why there was not a review on the education programs in 2012. Ms. Ellis explained because there is not a license type for the training programs there cannot be a renewal.

Ms. Ellis stated it would take a statutory change to create a new license type.




The Committee stated that they will table online training for the next meeting scheduled in May.
