44	regarding those that are on fixed income and how much of a rate increase could be tolerated.
45	General discussion of needing additional culinary sourcing, possible storage, and upgrades to the
46	water system.
47	General recognition that a rate increase is not desirable but most likely necessary with what is facing
48	the City.

51	3. Discussion regarding budgeting items for the 2021 and 2022 fiscal years.
52	Recorder Rydalch presented the Council with an approximation of Fiscal 2021 numbers. Asked
53	for input regarding budgeting projects for FY 2022. Councilmembers discussed water
54	improvements, road improvements, capital facility improvements to the park complex.
55	Recorder Rydalch is to prepare a preliminary budget for the Council to review in an upcoming
56	City Council meeting.
