Clerical Fees / GRAMA Request

Staff Hourly Rates: If research, manipulation, or preparation of information such as redaction, pixilation, and/or scan time is required, an hourly charge will be assessed if task takes longer than 15 minutes. The hourly rate will depend upon the lowest hourly rate of the employee with the proper security clearance and/or knowledge required to perform the task. Government Agencies may be eligible for a reduced rate.

Life Safety

Life Safety Plan: Review of new or existing structure for proper egress, access, lighting, and other life safety features; includes 1 in-person inspection.

\$100.00 per hour

Fire & Life Safety Violation:

Failure to comply with notices of violation of the Fire and Life Safety codes will result in the following:

- Per violation civil penalty in the amount of \$125.00

Continued non-compliance after the first civil penalty can result in the imposition of additional civil penalties, which are imposed daily. A second violation is \$250.00, in addition to the \$125.00 fine. Subsequent violations are \$500.00 per day. The filing of criminal charges may also occur. These additional penalties are possible if any violation(s) remain on the property, even if one or more violations are corrected. Persons who disagree with the finding of a violation may file an appeal with the Fire Chief of North Tooele Fire District within 10 consecutive days of the date listed on this inspection report/notice.

(This notice is in accordance with the International Fire Code). This shall not be construed as authority to violate, cancel, or set aside any applicable provisions of fire and life safety codes or those identified by other codes.)

Illegal Burning, Reckless Burning, Arson

Any person cited for illegal burning, reckless burning, or arson, may be held liable for the cost of the fire at the discretion of the North Tooele Fire District Fire Marshal and/or Fire Chief, including but not limited to the following:

- Per violation civil penalty in the amount of \$450.00
- Assignment - \$550.00 per hour, per apparatus.

When a fire is started by any person or persons that requires a fire department response during a time or season when fires are regulated or controlled by local or state rules, provisions or ordinances because of pollution or fire danger concerns, such person or persons will be liable for the fire department response at a cost not to exceed the actual expenses incurred by the fire department to respond and contain the fire.

Similarly, if a fire is started where permits are required for such a fire and the permit was not obtained and the fire department is required to respond to contain the fire the responsible party will be liable for the response at a cost not to exceed the actual expenses incurred by the fire department. The actual expenses will include direct labor, equipment costs and any other costs that can be reasonably allocated to the cost of the response.

Mitigation Rates

MITIGATION RATE NOTES

Itemized Response: NTFD reserves the option to bill each incident as an independent event with custom mitigation rates for each incident using itemized rates deemed usual, customary and reasonable (UCR). These incidents will be billed, itemized, per trained rescue person, plus rescue products use.

The mitigation rates below are average “billing levels”, and are typical for the incident responses listed, however, when a claim is submitted, it will be itemized and based on the actual services provided.

These average mitigation rates were determined by itemizing costs for a typical run (from the time a fire apparatus leaves the station until it returns to the station) and are based on the actual costs, using amortized schedules for apparatus (including useful life, equipment, repairs, and maintenance) and labor rates (an average department’s “actual personnel expense” and not just a firefighter's basic wage). The actual personnel expense includes costs such as wages, retirement, benefits, workers comp, insurance, etc.

Cost Recovery Rates listed in this document are part of a comprehensive Cost Recovery Policy adopted by North Tooele Fire District. Rate adjustments may occur by ordinance/resolution to keep the fire department's cost recovery program in conformity with increasing operating expenses. However, Cost Recovery Rates are only subject to change upon a public review and ordinance/resolution adoption by the North Tooele Fire District Board of Trustees.

Motor Vehicle Incidents

Level 1	Provide hazardous materials assessment and scene stabilization. This will be the most common “billing level”. This occurs almost every time the fire department responds to an accident/incident.	\$550.00
Level 2	Includes Level 1 services as well as clean up and material used (absorbents) for hazardous fluid clean up and disposal, including cleanup of any gasoline or other automotive fluids that are spilled as a result of the accident/incident.	\$650.00
Level 3	CAR FIRE - Provide scene safety, fire suppression, breathing air, rescue tools, hand tools, hose, tip use, foam, structure protection, and clean up gasoline or other automotive fluids that are spilled as a result of the accident/incident.	\$750.00

Other Services

Extrication	Includes heavy rescue tools, ropes, airbags, cribbing etc. This charge will be added if extrication equipment is used for any reason. Charges will not be assessed at this level if the patient is simply unconscious, and the fire department is able to open the door to access the patient.	\$1600.00
Creating a Landing Zone	Any time a landing zone is created and/or is utilized to transport the patient(s), including multi-engine company response, mutual aid, helicopter, fixed wing.	\$500.00
ADDITIONAL TIME ON-SCENE	Engine billed at \$450.00 per hour. Truck billed at \$550.00 per hour. Miscellaneous equipment billed at \$300.00. Additional scene time begins at termination of emergency operations.	

HAZMAT Response

Level 1	Basic Response: Claim will include engine response, first responder assignment, perimeter establishment, evacuations, set-up and command.	\$800.00
Level 2	Intermediate Response: Claim will include engine response, first responder assignment, hazmat certified team and appropriate equipment, perimeter establishment, evacuations, set-up and command, Level A or B suit donning, breathing air and detection equipment. Set-up and removal of decontamination center.	\$2,850.00
Level 3	Advanced Response: Claim will include engine response, first responder assignment, hazmat certified team and appropriate equipment, perimeter establishment, evacuations, first responder set-up and command, Level A or B suit donning, breathing air and detection equipment and robot deployment. Set-up and removal of decontamination center, detection equipment, recovery, and identification of material. Disposal and environment clean up. Includes above in addition to any disposal rates of material and contaminated equipment and material used at scene.	\$6,700.00

Ambulance

As a licensed ambulance provider, NTFD may charge base and mileage rates for ambulance and paramedic services. Ambulance rates, surcharges, and special provisions assessed by the North Tooele Fire District will automatically reflect the most current allowable rates approved by the Utah Department of Health. In addition, as a licensed ambulance provider, NTFD may charge for supplies and for providing supplies, medications, and administering medications used on any response if supplies and medications are priced fairly and competitively, the individual does not refuse service, and the licensed personnel for the licensed provider assess or treat the individual.

Payment of Fees

All fees shall be made payable to: North Tooele Fire District, 179 Country Club, Stansbury Park, UT 84074, in the form of cash, check, money order or electronic payment via online/credit card. A \$50.00 charge will be assessed on all returned payments. **GRAMA request fees and Permit fees must be received at the district office prior to the issuance of the records/permit.** All other fees will be invoiced upon completion of the service and due within 10 days. A fee of \$10.00 plus 1.5% interest per month will be assessed on all late accounts. Any and all fees may be waived or decreased at the discretion of the Fire Chief and/or the Fire Marshal.
