



Washington County School Board:

I would like to request an amendment to our TSSA Budget to allow us to spend \$936 on ESGI software for Hurricane Elementary First Grade teachers. This would allow 4 licenses for teachers to use ESGI and quickly assess student knowledge and give feedback to students.

ESGI testing software allows teachers to assess students in one-on-one and small group situations quickly; share assessments and data; create charts, graphs, and reports; create instructional resources based on test data; and communicate data clearly with parents.

This funding change would support our first goal, which is that "teachers will create a guaranteed and viable curriculum in Language Arts in order to increase language arts RISE scores... Targets will be tied to common formative assessments. Other State assessments (KEEPAA, Acadience, etc.) will be administered BOY, MOY, and EOY."
