



Preparing students for life

Dear Washington County School Board:

We would like to make an amendment to Hurricane High School's TSSA spend plan under goal **#3 (LEADERSHIP, CULTURE, COACHING, COLLABORATION & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT)..**

We feel that one way to improve student learning (goal #1 in our TSSA spend plan) is to improve teacher training and professional development. We are requesting to add to our TSSA the following for the 2023/24 school year:

Provide Professional Development training for teacher teams offsite - the breakdown would be as follows:

1. \$10,000 for PD travel (per diem, hotel, car rental)
2. \$5000 for Substitutes while teachers are doing PD
3. \$5000 for PD conference fees

We would also like to allocate funding under goal #3 subsection #2. **Promote student/ teacher engagement and involvement in clubs and extracurricular.**

We would like to provide \$15,000 to our robotics club as they continue to compete at the world level each year.

Under goal #2 Increase students' social and emotional well being at HHS. We would like to allocate \$5000 to purchase two AED devices so that each floor is equipped with a life saving device. We feel this will benefit students' emotional wellbeing as they see a commitment from HHS to provide life saving devices should a need arise.
