BUSINESS ITEM(S)

1. Facilities Division Report, Jeff Martin

Jeff Martin, our facilities manager, presented an overview of projects he and his staff have worked on throughout the city. Some of the projects that we have been part of are our city representatives on the new city hall building, Murray Mansion, theater restoration, golf course, park center updates, outdoor pool issues, public works roof, and the police training center range. The facilities division consists of 6 full-time and 25 part-time employees. They have been a new division under Parks and Recreation for 6-7 years now.

2. Project Updates

Theater – We ran into an issue this week with too much groundwater. We have a temporary draining system in place, but we are looking at options to find a more permanent solution.

Mansion – The Murray Mansion is coming along but going a little slower than originally anticipated.

Armory – Bids opened a couple of weeks ago with currently two bids in. Paulsen Construction was selected as the contractor.

Riverview Playground – Bruce introduced Lewis Painter, who is in attendance, as a

representative from Great Western Playground. He has done some renditions of a natural theme with a river blended in the pour in place to help spark imagination for role-play games. Colors help draw boundaries for the 2–5-year area with a lot of sensory features along with another area indicating a more challenging area for the older children. Graduated levels of features for age groups to participate in with imaginative elements. Darren motioned to approve the plans for the new playground project. Kim seconded. All voted in favor. Temperatures will determine the final installation date, but hopefully early spring.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

One change was noted the Centennial Celebration has been changed to June 15, 2023, not July 6, as originally planned. Ted has started the process of the car show to include two Utah car clubs displaying vintage cars, A company selected to play music, and movie props for citizens to take pictures alongside the cars.
