2014 STIP Workshop  
April 17, 2014  
Salt Lake City, Utah**

The 2014 STIP Workshop convened at 8:01 a.m. Executive Director Carlos Braceras welcomed those attending, gave an overview of the objectives of the workshop, and briefly talked about funding. Chairman Jeff Holt excused Commissioner Millington and made general comments about the workshop and funding as well. Introductions were made of those attending.

Cory Pope, Director for Program Development, recapped the agenda and explained the STIP process cycle that gets them to where they are today. He also discussed the goals of today's workshop. Bill Lawrence, Program Finance Director, gave a Program Status Update that included programming subtleties, federal program overall status, ePM program status reports, and a funding fact sheets overview. Becky Bradshaw, Finance Director, reviewed the 2014 revenue forecast and said the revenue projected for 2014 is \$447.9 million. There was additional discussion regarding B & C Road Funds. Mr. Lawrence continued with a Program Funding overview, including Federal Program Outlook and Funding, State Transportation Funds, and Transportation Investment Funds. Following a short break, each Region Director reviewed several important projects in various funding categories that were within their region boundaries.

A working lunch presentation was given by Stan Burns, Asset Management. His presentation covered the following: Data Inventory Project, Integration of Inventory & UPlan/UGate, Design – “As-Builts” and Pt Cloud in Design – and Industry Collaboration. Following the Asset Management presentation, the Prioritization Process was reviewed. Mr. Lawrence explained the requirements and strategic direction, preservation and rehabilitation, mobility, and safety. The next in depth review and discussion took place regarding program recommendations. Mr. Lawrence and Bob Pelly, STIP Coordinator, led the discussion on the each of the following programs: State Funds, Preservation, Minor Rehabilitation, Major Rehabilitation, Bridge, Capacity, Choke Point, Safety, Signs & Culverts, and the Joint Highway Committee. For the final agenda item, Region Contingency Funds, a report was given by the four Region Directors on the use of their contingency funds during the past year. Each director highlighted a few notable projects.

Chairman Holt reminded the Region Directors to make sure they were talking to their Commissioners about projects. Mr. Pope wrapped up the workshop and said a lot of information has been covered today. Take time to look it over, and if there are any questions, contact the Programming staff or Region Directors at any time.
