ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

Minutes: Following review, Trustee Schultz made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 1, 2023 regular meeting, as presented. Trustee Robinson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

LEGAL MATTERS

Public Hearing to Receive Input from the Public with Respect to (a) the issuance by the District of its Limited Tax General Obligation Bonds, Series 2023 and (b) any Potential Economic Impact that the Project to be Financed with the Proceeds of the Bonds may have on the Private Sector: Following discussion, Trustee Schultz made a motion to open the Public Hearing to receive input from the public with respect to (a) the issuance by the District of its Limited Tax General Obligation Bonds, Series 2023 and (b) any potential economic impact that the Project to be financed with the proceeds of the Bonds may have on the private sector at 2:03 p.m. Trustee Robinson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Proposed Amendment to the Operating and Capital Budget for Calendar Year 2023 and Public Hearing to take Public Comment on the Same: This item was deferred to the next meeting.

Tentative Operating and Capital Budget for Calendar Year 2024 and Public Hearing to take Public Comment on the Same: Ms. Clymer reviewed the tentative budget with the Board. Following review, Trustee Robinson made a motion to approve the tentative operating and capital budget for calendar year 2024, subject to changes with the bond transaction. Trustee Schultz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The Board set a public hearing date for December 11, 2023 at 11:00 a.m.

CliftonLarsonAllen LLP for Forecast & Accounting: Following discussion, Trustee Schultz made a motion to ratify approval of engaging CLA for Cash Flow Forecast services. Trustee Robinson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

CliftonLarsonAllen LLP Master Services Agreement and Statements of Work for 2024: Following discussion, Trustee Robinson made a motion to approve the CLA Master Services Agreement and Statements of Work for 2024. Trustee Schultz seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
