APPOINTMENTS:

David Jessie Riddle – Riddle Construction Inc.

Ms. Pettley reviewed the Mr. Riddle's criminal background and summarized Mr. Riddle's previous meeting with the Commission. Mr. Riddle's attorney, Run-Zhi Lai made a statement to the Commission, and outlined certain conditions Mr. Riddle would agree to in a probation stipulation. Mr. Simonsen addressed Mr. Riddle and explained that some of the comments he made during his last appointment with the Commission regarding his planned hiring practices were alarming to the Commission members and that was why his previous application was denied. Mr. Lai explained that Mr. Riddle would agree to not hire anyone on the sex

offender registry. The Commission discussed what additional stipulations and reporting requirements would need to be added to a probationary stipulation in order for them to move forward with granting Mr. Riddle a license on probation. After some discussion, the Commission determined that in addition to the standard probation stipulation language, there would need to be a requirement for Mr. Riddle to verify that all subcontractors he hires have active licenses in good standing with DOPL and are not on probation, and require that DOPL monitor Mr. Riddle's W-2 employees through reports from the Utah Department of Workforce Services to ensure Mr. Riddle does not employ anyone with a similar criminal background. Mr. Peterson made a motion to grant Mr. Riddle B-100 and E-100 licenses on probation with the added requirements that Mr. Riddle verify that all subcontractors he hires have active licenses in good standing with DOPL, and that DOPL monitor Mr. Riddle's W-2 employees through reports from the Department of Workforce Services to ensure Mr. Riddle does not employ anyone with a similar criminal background. Before there was a second to the motion, Mr. Simonsen stated he would like to review the stipulation prior to approving it. Mr. Simonsen believes this will be helpful for the new Commission members so that they are able to see a probation stipulation prior to approving one. Therefore, Mr. Peterson withdrew his motion. DOPL will work with the Utah Attorney General's office and Mr. Lai to draft a probation stipulation for Mr. Riddle and provide it to the Commission for their review prior to the next meeting; and the Commission will vote on the stipulation at that time.
