Language Kits

Materials in this collection consist of print and read-along books in world languages, geared towards various age groups from Pre-K to young adult. Each kit contains a selection of multiple titles.

Selection Criteria Summary

Authority and reliability; Language authenticity;

Reliability and reputation of the publisher;

Anticipated usage or requests by school libraries

Author's qualifications and other published works;

Literary awards or evaluations in reviews/media;

Accuracy and timeliness of content;

Representation of unique or points of view with consideration of above criteria;

Affordability.

Deselection Policy

In order to provide a current, accurate and useful collection the Utah State Library will perform regular deselection of materials based on the following criteria:

- 1. Misleading—factually inaccurate;
- 2. Outdated—age of document;
- 3. Condition—worn beyond mending and rebinding;
- 4. Superseded—by a new edition or a much better book on the subject;
- 5. Trivial—of no discernible literary or scientific merit;
- 6. Irrelevant to the needs or interests of the library's community;
- 7. Elsewhere—the material is easily obtainable from another library;
- 8. Low Usage—Usage drops below acceptable.
