RESOLUTION NO. 23-069

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS OF THE CITY OF WEST
JORDAN APPROVING THE CANVASS OF
THE 2023 CITY OF WEST JORDAN MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION AND
DECLARING THE HIGHEST VOTE RECIPIENTS AS ELECTED**

WHEREAS, the Board of Canvassers of the City of West Jordan (“City” and the “Board” or “Board of Canvassers”), consisting of the City’s Mayor and its City Council, met on December 6, 2023, to canvass the returns of the City’s 2023 General Election held on November 21, 2023 (“General Election”); and

WHEREAS, the Board must canvass the returns of the General Election as required by law to declare the highest vote recipients in the General Election as “elected”; and

WHEREAS, the Salt Lake County Elections Representatives (“SLCE Representatives”) reviewed ballots cast on or before November 21, 2023 during the evening of the General Election; and

WHEREAS, the SLCE Representatives reviewed the mail-in and absentee ballots received after November 21, 2023 to determine eligibility; and

WHEREAS, the SLCE Representatives verified the eligible mail-in and absentee ballots and accepted them; and

WHEREAS, the SLCE Representatives verified the eligible provisional ballots and accepted them; and

WHEREAS, the SLCE Representatives merged mail-in, absentee, and provisional ballots with the election night (November 21, 2023) results to produce final results; and

WHEREAS, the City Recorder, as the City Election Officer, presented her report to the Board, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, which contains the final results for the General Election (“Final Results”, “Election Officer’s Certification Report”, or “Certification Report”); and

WHEREAS, the Board is satisfied with the accuracy of the Final Results presented.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Canvassers of City of West Jordan as follows:

Section 1. Certification. The Board certifies the votes as set forth in the Election Officer's Certification Report for the November 21, 2023 General Election, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, as the final vote total for the General Election. All members of the Board ("Board Members") voting "Yes" to this Resolution shall independently sign the Certification Report attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. Declaration. Pursuant to the certified results of the General Election, the Board declares the following candidates for the offices of Mayor, District 1 Councilmember, District 2 Councilmember, District 3 Councilmember, and District 4 Councilmember, as elected:

Mayor: Dirk Burton

District 1 Councilmember: Chad Lamb

District 2 Councilmember: Bob Bedore

District 3 Councilmember: Zach Jacob

District 4 Councilmember: Kent Shelton


