Not a lot to report on, a grant application opening for the road master plan will follow up with Dave Oxman to make sure we apply for that grant. Mayor stated Dave is already looking into two different engineer firms to see if we need their help with the grant.

Russell G. Keisel

Britanny said that Utah Valley has a swim club that is going to pay \$500 to come and use the facility. Said he was interested in the cameras that we had a presentation on earlier in the day. Stated he noticed people have been out there to the Contoy doing donuts still was hoping cameras would help catch them. Wanted to know what happened to our signs we were going to put up at the Contoy. Brought up we need a new Chief of Police, that Steve Grey would like to apply however he lives 7 minutes instead of 5 minutes. Mayor asked Shane Ward and Colter Allen to see what their thoughts were on the Chief living in City limits. Both Colter and Shane say that it is helpful to have them live inside the city limits. Sam Draper stated that they will not hire anyone outside of City limits for the Fire Department. Russell Keisel would like to have the 5-minute rule removed from the policy. Mayor Olsen stated that the 5-minute rule is stated weird in the policy. Mayor Olsen felt like we should have Jim look into his SOP and see how they compare to our City Policy. Mayor Olsen also stated that the Sheriff's Department is going to pull the resource officer out of the High School next year. Chief Wilberg told the school district that Mt. Pleasant Police would respond when they needed us to but we as the City would not be able to provide a full-time officer right now.

There will be a mental health class on 11/29/2023 at the High School. December 4th there is a live Nativity at the Mt. Pleasant City Park, it's free to the Public.

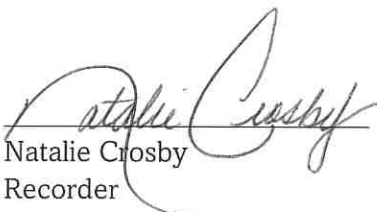
