DABC Commission Policy on Consideration of Applications: Adopted December 27, 2016

PENDING VIOLATIONS:

From this point forward the commission will not consider applications where there is a pending violation.

For the purpose of this policy, pending violations applies to all licenses where there is common ownership of 20% or more.

VIOLATION HISTORY:

From this point forward, the commission will not consider new license applications for **three months** after the final commission order for any serious or grave violations.

Further, all applicants with a violation of serious or grave in the last four months to a year will be required to appear before the commission to address whether a new license should be granted. The commission would consider number of violations and all mitigating/aggravating factors in determining when, if at all, to grant a license.

For the purpose of this policy, violation history applies to all licenses where there is common ownership of 20% or more.

Staff is instructed to inform applicants with a pending violation or a violation history in the last three months to apply after the prescribed periods.
