I, Gabriel Woytek, Clerk/Auditor of Grand County do hereby notify that the following offices are to be filled at the regular general election to be held in Grand County on Tuesday, November 5, 2024.

1. FEDERAL

- a. President and Vice-President for a four (4) year term.
- b. U.S. Senate. One Senator for a six (6) year term.
- c. U.S. House of Representatives. One representative for a two (2) year term in the Third U.S. Congressional District consisting of Carbon, Daggett, Duchesne, Emery, Grand, San Juan, Uintah, and Wasatch Counties as well as portions of Salt Lake, Summit, and Utah Counties.

2. **STATE**

- a. State executive. Each of the following positions will be elected for a four (4) year term.
 - (1) Governor
 - (2) Lieutenant Governor
 - (3) Attorney General
 - (4) State Auditor
 - (5) State Treasurer
- b. State Senate. One Utah State Senator from State Senate District Twenty-Six (26) for a four (4) year term. District Twenty-six (26) is located in Carbon, Emery, Grand, San Juan, and Wasatch Counties and portions of Garfield, Kane, Utah, and Wayne Counties.
- c. State House of Representatives. One member of the Utah House of Representatives for a two (2) year term from each of the seventy-five (75) state legislative districts.

3. <u>COUNTY</u>

- a. County Commission: One County Commission member for each of the following Commission Districts (4 total):
 Commission District # 1: Voting District 1
 Commission District # 2: Voting District 2
 Commission District # 3: Voting District 3
 One County Commissioner from the County At-Large
- b. County Assessor: At-Large
- c. County Recorder: At-Large
- d. County Surveyor: At-Large
- e. County Treasurer: At-Large

4. SCHOOL BOARD

- a. Local School Boards. One member for a four-year term from each of the following school precincts: School District #2: Voting District 2
 - School District #3: Voting District 3
 - School District #4: Voting District 4

5. <u>SPECIAL DISTRICTS</u>

- a. Moab Valley Fire Protection District. Two trustee seats for a four-year term.
- b. Spanish Valley Water and Sewer Improvement District. Two trustee seats for a four-year term.

6. JUDICIAL

- a. Supreme Court. There will be a retention election for one (1) Supreme Court Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- b. Court of Appeals. There will be a retention election for one (1) Court of Appeals Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- c. District Court. Seventh District. One (1) Judge in the Seventh Judicial District, which consists of Carbon, Emery, Grand, and San Juan Counties.
- d. Justice Court. All Justice Court judges shall be subject to an unopposed retention election in the county in which the court to which the judge is appointed is located.

All persons intending to become candidates for any elective county, district office, or school district office within Grand County in the 2024 election shall file a Declaration of Candidacy with the Grand County Clerk/Auditor between 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 2, 2024, through 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 8, 2024. Petition templates for unaffiliated candidates will be available at the County Clerk's Office starting on Friday, December 1st between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Partisan candidates must first declare candidacy during the above referenced declaration filing period before beginning the signature gathering process.
