RESOLUTION NO. R2024-

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY COUNCIL APPOINTING A NEW TRUSTEE TO THE BOARD OF DOWNTOWN EAST STREETCAR SEWER PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE DISTRICT

WHEREAS the Downtown East Streetcar Sewer Public Infrastructure District (the "District") is a public infrastructure district located within the boundaries of South Salt Lake City, which was the creating entity of the District; and

WHEREAS the City Council, as the legislative body of the City, is empowered by Utah Code Title 17B Chapter 1 (the "Special District Act"), Title 17D Chapter 4 (the "PID Act"), and the Governing Document of the District, to appoint trustees to the District's Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS a seat on the Board of Trustees has become vacant, and the seat has not yet transitioned to an elected seat pursuant to the Governing Document, therefore a new trustee must be appointed; and

WHEREAS the Governing Document of the District requires a vacated seat be filled pursuant to the Special District Act; however, as there are no eligible residents within the boundaries of the District, a resident cannot be appointed; and

WHEREAS the PID Act, Utah Code § 17D-4-202(3)(c), states that a non-resident may only serve as a board member if the person is an owner of land within the District, or an agent or officer of the owner of land, and must be a registered voter at that person's primary residence; and

WHEREAS a quorum of the Board of Trustees of the PID, themselves representing owners of land within the District, have nominated Steve Borup to fill the vacant seat on the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS Mr. Borup is an agent or officer of an owner of land within the District and is a registered voter at the place of his primary residence.

Now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of South Salt Lake as follows:

- 1. Steve Borup, being the only person meeting the qualifications for appointment to the Board of Trustees of the District as stated in the PID Act, Utah Code § 17D-4-202(3)(c), is hereby appointed to fill the vacant seat on the Board.
- 2. The seat filled by Mr. Borup was originally held by Jeff Gochnour, who was appointed for an initial six-year term. Mr. Borup will serve the remainder of the initial six-year term, or until such earlier time as he is unable or unwilling to serve.
- 3. Mr. Borup shall be required to maintain his status as a registered voter during the time of his service on the Board.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately and shall be filed with the City Recorder as soon as practicable.

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH SALT LAKE CITY COUNCIL ACKNOWLEDGING RECEIPT OF THE INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT DRAFT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 AND THAT NOTICE BE PUBLISHED PURSUANT TO SECTION 10-6-152 OF THE UTAH CODE WHEN THE FINAL REPORT IS COMPLETED

WHEREAS, Utah Code Sections 10-6-151, 51-2a-201, 51-2a-202, as amended, requires the City to have, at least annually, an independent financial audit of its accounts by a certified public accountant; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code § 10-6-152, within ten (10) days following the receipt of the auditor's report the City is required to publish notice advising the public that the report is complete and available for inspection; and

WHEREAS, the City retained Squire & Company, certified public accountants, to perform an independent financial audit of the City's accounts for fiscal year 2022-23; and

WHEREAS, Squire & Company has presented the audit report draft to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the South Salt Lake City Council desires to acknowledge receipt of the audit report draft and order that notice be published pursuant to Utah Code § 10-6-152 when the final report is completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH SALT LAKE AS FOLLOWS:

It hereby acknowledges that the audit report draft of the City's accounts for fiscal year 2022-23 has been completed by Squire & Company and submitted to the South Salt Lake City Council. When the final report is completed, the City Recorder is directed to publish notice advising the public that the audit report is complete and available for inspection.
