  - Resolution 21-2023, a resolution approving and reestablishing the annual meeting schedule for the Board of Trustees of the District for the calendar year of 2024 and providing for an effective date.

- 7. Review and Approval of Amended Rules and Regulations:

  - 200.02 FMLA
    - Three sections were added to the FMLA Rules and Regulation to clarify what constitutes time off during FMLA.
    - Motion to approve Rules and Regulations 200.02 FMLA made by Val, second by Gordon.
    - All present members voted aye. Passes unanimously.
  - 300.03 Severance Pay
    - This new policy will protect appointed employees from being terminated without cause without pay security. Gordon asked if contracts would be better for our currently appointed employees. Discussion about the pros and cons of each.
    - Motion to approve Rules and Regulations 300.03 Severance Pay made by Scott, second by David.
    - All present members voted ave. Passes unanimously.
