


**NOTICE OF VACANCY ON THE NORTH FORK SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT

All letters of interest must be received by the Board of County Commissioners, Utah County, Utah, ("Commission") on or before 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 16, 2024. The Commission will review and evaluate all individuals that qualify for consideration pursuant to the guidelines listed above and will appoint individuals to fill the Board vacancies by resolution.




