Jason Krebs mentioned the NRCS grant is complete for the no till drill. It needs to be ordered as soon as possible. There was a brief discussion on Truax vs Great Plains. He said to be thinking about how to do rental agreements, deposits, and maintenance. Jason Krebs also suggested doing a solid health day in Wayne County to show off the drill and teach producers how to use it. Kerry Cook mentioned that we are waiting on Kristy Davis to get info on the CSP grant.

Trent Wilde reminded the group that pesticide licenses need to be renewed before the end of the month.

#### NRCS
