FREMONT CD MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Kerry Cook Called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

FINANCIAL

Daniel Brinkerhoff seconded it. All in Favor.** The grant agreement with the state for \$11,000 was reviewed and signed.

The Central Utah Grazing Expo is Oct 17-19. UACD Convention is the 7th & 8th of November. There was a brief discussion about what items could be donated for the auxiliary auction. NASCA is October 1-4th. There is a Colorado River representative coming for a visit November 1-3rd.

CONSERVATION BUSINESS

Morgan Wood made a motion to sponsor \$500 for the Central Utah Grazing Expo. James Pace seconded it. All in favor. Trent Wilde will get an invoice to the board. The plan of work was tabled until September's meeting. **Morgan Wood made a motion to approve and sign the clerk contract. Daniel Brinkerhoff seconded it. All in Favor.** The clerk contract was signed.



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UDAF

Jason Krebs gave an update on the grant for equipment that was submitted. He said they are still waiting on a decision. He should know in the next two weeks. The cost for the no till drill is about 33K. Jason will email the total amount to the board. He also mentioned that they are doing a field day with the same kind of no till drill that is being purchased. It will be held in Sanpete county in September.

NRCS

Wade Ingram gave an update on SFP. It was approved. He mentioned that the current contracts in Wayne county are 1.2 million. CSP renewals are going on now as well. EWP is assessing flood damages now. If anyone has questions they can contact Kyle Wheeler. The application deadline for 2024 is October 1st.

WATERSHED

Breanne Bloomfield handed out a contact list of partners. She mentioned that Morgan Wood, James Pace, and Daniel Brinkerhoff are up for re-appointment this year. She handed out information on a proposed campground by Capitol Reef. Breanne mentioned that ARDL loans are running between 2.7 and 3.25% right now. She gave out some brochures to give to interested producers. She also left some Ag VIP applications. The deadline for them is Sept 30th.

Breanne gave a sampling update. No E-coli was found. Calf Creek and Otter Creek have a red warning. She handed out her plan of work that needs to be signed by the board. The board will review and go over it in the next meeting.
