COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:

Rod McGary, Mayor Pro-Tem, opened the public hearing and turned the time over to Tammie Morgan to conduct the hearing.

Tammie stated:

The purpose of this public hearing is to provide citizens with pertinent information about the Community Development Block Grant program and to allow for discussion of possible applications for the 2024 funding cycle. The grant money must be spent on projects benefiting primarily low- and moderate-income persons. The Bear River Association of Governments is expecting to receive approximately \$900,000 in this new program year. All eligible activities that can be accomplished under this program are identified in the CDBG Application Policies and Procedures Manual and interested persons can review it at any time. Examples of eligible activities include the construction of public works and facilities such as water and sewer lines and fire stations. Other examples of eligible activities also include the acquisition of real property and the provision of public services such as food banks or homeless shelters. In the past, Snowville has received funding for stormwater management improvements, emergency vehicle acquisition, and curb gutter and sidewalk installation. These activities are listed in the Regional "Consolidated Plan". This list shows which projects Snowville has identified as being needed in the community.
