Presentations for approval by Judi Yaworsky, RN - Maturation Programs for 5th and 6th grade boys and girls - Presentation on Blood Born Pathogens <i>Judi Yaworski presented the maturation programs the District Nurses use for 5th and 6th grade students.</i> <i>Beginning of each presentation is about change. Change is always happening and is normal and natural.</i> <i>Students are always reminded to talk to parents, guardians or other trusted adults if they have questions.</i> <i>Students are given an overview on how each other's bodies are changing and an explanation of the reproductive systems. Puberty is a natural, gradual process of becoming an adult.</i> <i>Girls are given more details about how their bodies are changing.</i> <i>Girls are given information about menstruation.</i> <i>Boys are given information about how their bodies are changing.</i> <i>The committee asked Judi to include information about circumcision and religious traditions.</i> <i>The committee asked Judi to be sure to use the word "typical" instead of "normal."</i> <i>There was a discussion about how best to present to non-binary students.</i> <i>It was decided the presentation on Blood Borne Pathogens would be held at a later meeting.</i>
