

PHONE SYSTEM

- Current phone system is EOL this year
- Phones are proprietary and need replaced, phone lines are provided by CenturyLink / Lumen
- 2 main options
 - 1 - Stay with our current provider (Mitel) and try to keep the system in-house
 - 2 - Migrate to a cloud based system (Ring Central)



Option 1 - Mitel MiVoice Business

- Up front cost of \$29K-\$114K depending on current promos
- Phone replacement cost of \$77K
 - Still somewhat proprietary
- Fax service not included but could be added (\$20/line/mo)
- We purchase, maintain and replace equipment
- Annual recurring cost - \$34,850 (Plus any fax capabilities)
 - \$27,261 each year to Century Link / Lumen



Option 2 - Ring Central (Cloud VoIP)

- Up front cost of \$26K
- Phone replacement cost of \$26K
 - Standard VoIP phones - can be used on other systems
- Fax service included for all lines, as is texting and IM
- No on-site equipment besides phones
- Phone lines are ported to Ring Central as the carrier
- Annual recurring cost - \$47,001 (including phone lines)
- Softphone and mobile support, call transferability
- We would need to engineer a disaster level failover path for phones to connect to in the event of a complete internet outage.

PHONE SYSTEM

- Our recommendation would be to migrate to Ring Central cloud based VoIP system
- We would carry through our capital equipment budget
- One other note:
This does include the 36 phones at the courts. I'm not sure what our historical arrangement with them was.
 - Should they be paying part of the cost of this project?
 - Should they be moved to their own county system?
 - Should they have been paying part of our annual system maintenance costs?
