



EA Policy - 3A.01.003 Uniform Policy 2024-2025

Information Pertaining To All Students

Casual Dress Day: Clean, modest clothing, shirts with sleeves, pants cannot have holes. Shorts, skorts, and skirts may not be any shorter than 3 inches above the knee. Clothing should be free of negative messaging including obscenity or profanity. No pajamas, hats, or any item of clothing that is distracting.

Lion Pride Day: School approved t-shirts may be worn on selected days with uniform style bottoms or jeans with no holes, rips, or tears.

Uniform compliance will be left to the discretion of the school director.

When masks are worn at school, masks should have no vulgar language or negative messaging, and no obscenity or profanity.

All clothing items worn for warmth in the classroom must be non-hooded. 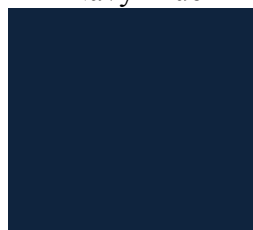

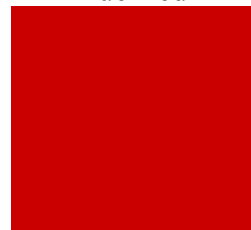

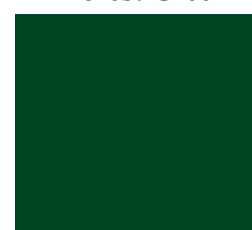

Date Adopted: February 2009

Amended: January 2010 – Allowable skirt lengths were changed from 2 in. above the knee when kneeling to 3 in. above the knee when kneeling. Yellow (not gold) was added as an allowed color for girl's dresses.

Amended: May 2010 – Minor wording clarifications. Removed turtlenecks and mock turtlenecks. Removed sewn flat cargo pockets. Added exemptions paragraph and financial hardship paragraph.

Amended: January 2011 - Restricted tops to polo's, restricted jackets and sweaters to navy only with no hoodies, and required Excelsior logos only on sweaters and jackets.

Amended: March 2011 - Removed requirement for Excelsior logos only on jackets and sweaters.

Amended: January 2012 - changed yellow to canary yellow, added no slippers, removed redundant paragraphs, took out navy vests, added cuffs and lining to bullet point 3 under Shirts/Tops, added the color navy to leggings.

Amended: March 2012 - added the no hoodies because that should have been in there from previous vote, changed the undergarment section to must be solid white with no pattern or lace, pants must be uniform style; no cargo, painter, corduroy pants or shorts to be worn was added, No distracting laces on shoes; blue, black, white or brown lace color is preferred was added too.

Amended: January 2016- Took out white polos allowed, and added true red and forest green as a color for the Sweaters, jackets or sweater vests. Also added required in the heading.

Amended: January 2017- Took out the words no jeggings.

Amended: January 09-2019- Took out joggers. Added under girls Dresses, Jumpers & skirts section. "Leggings must be knee length or longer.

Added "Uniform compliance will be left to the discretion of the school director." Added on pajamas dress down days.

Amended: June 17, 2020: Added the sentence about masks

Amended: January 20, 2021: The EA lion sweatshirt may be worn over a uniform shirt. No hoodie sweatshirts.

Amended: January 28, 2022. Change the word required masks to when masks are worn. Add grey color to the sweater wording.

Amended: January 19, 2023. Added solid in color, sweatshirts, and team jackets to the sweaters section. Added a short length to the boy pant section. Added no messaging to hair accessories. Added no foam shoes wording. Removed plaid from the girl's pant section. Added hats cannot be worn
