A. Minute Approval

B.1. Dec Minutes: Jason Yeaman approved, Marlene Teter second, none opposed.

C. New Business:

- C.1. New Arts Council Members-** We have two new arts council members that will be appointed at the Jan 16 City Council meeting. Laura and Aldo are also both up for re-appointments and both of them have agreed to stay on the Arts Council.
- C.2. January Art Classes-** We have two adult Art classes and a Youth Art class scheduled in January. All three classes are full.
- C.3. SoJo Summerfest Music poster-** As of today we have not had any entries for the poster contest. They have until January 31 to submit an entry. All members were asked to help speed the word.
- C.4. Art Swap- Scheduled for Saturday Feb 24-** This is a Saturday from 4-6pm. All Arts Council members are encouraged to sign up and bring a piece to swap.
- C.5. Art Show- open for registration until March 4 (or until full)-** All Arts Council members will be asked to judge. Judging will be held on Thursday March 21 from 4-6pm and Friday March 22 from 9am-4pm.
- C.6. Dueling Pianos- Date change-** Due to Killer Keyz availability, the Dueling Pianos will be held on Friday August 16 2024.
- C.7. Art on the Towne and Quilt Show dates-** Date of event is Saturday May 11. We would like any Arts Council members that would be willing to judge the quilt show that morning.
- C.8. Public Art discussion-** We talked about public art for the rest of the FY23-24 budget as well as ideas for the FY24-25 budget. For the FY23-24 current budget, we would like to focus on adding some smaller murals around the City to use as part of our Art-Venture. Ideas of either a small animal on City Buildings like the fire station, or pipe paintings at park pavilions and other areas in the City. For the FY24-25 budget, we are moving to the February Arts Council meeting for further discussion. Arts Council members were asked to think about their goals and what they want to achieve with the Artwork. We also need to keep on track with the focus of the Arts Master Plan.

C.9. Bylaws- update- Arts Council voted on the following changes to the Arts Council Bylaws

A. Section 1- Arts Council shall consist of 12 members, will be amended to 6-12 members.

B. Section 2- The Chair and Vice Chair shall be elected in July and assume duties in August, will be moved to the first of the year after when new City Council is seated and appointed.

Marlene Teter approved the motion to update the bylaws and Janis McClellan seconded the motion, none opposed.

Misc. Items. Theater auditions will be held on Wednesday and Thursday Feb 28/29 at the Community Center from 6:30-9pm.
The Arts Council Presentation to City Council needs to be set up. Janell will see if we can get it on the February 6th meeting agenda, Tiffany will make the presentation and Laura will present to City Council.
