

Proposed Amendments to Admissions Policy...

Edith Bowen Laboratory School may consider for admission all children who will reside in the State of Utah and submit a timely application. In compliance with Utah Code, a charter school may give enrollment preference to children of founding board members, children of teachers employed at the school, and siblings of pupils who ~~have been or~~ will be actively enrolled in the charter school at the time of enrollment of the sibling. Each spring after the application deadline, if the size of the applicant pool exceeds the capacity of a grade level, a lottery will be held and a new priority list will be determined for each grade level for the coming school year. Siblings of pupils who will be actively enrolled at the school in the coming year will take priority on this list. ~~This list will remain through the grade levels until it is extinguished. Openings will be filled by alternating between the sibling list and the priority list. Each year a lottery will be held to add new names to the existing priority list for each grade level.~~ With the exception of siblings, no new students will be enrolled after ~~October 1st~~ March 1st for that school year. Parents who have children actively enrolled in the School and who desire their siblings to be considered for admission must inform the School by formal application by a date determined by the school.
