#### **Reports**

- Executive Director Report, Bonita Teasley
  - Enrollment = 244 students, 8<sup>th</sup> grade highest enrollment
  - USU Goals revisited with corresponding action items for achievement. We are seeing improved metrics. Camera use has jumped to 95% in MS/HS, 96% K5. Math attendance in K5 is 83% semester 2, a 2% increase. MS/HS math attendance semester 2 dropped from 79% to 73%. Observation schedule has been created with short cycle feedback. Kelvyn questioned the training of LOPT. USU reviewing CAU's plan in reference to goals 3 and 4. CAU would still like to receive a training from USU to ensure that observations are objective. Kelvyn asked if we were comfortable with the LOPT. Bonita feels that it needs to be

calibrated to reduce subjectivity element but does feel like there are cornerstones of good teaching. Rikki questioned where we need USU support. Bonita responded that she would like a TOT training to calibrate the LOPT. We are assuming training will happen once USE reviews the plan.

- Attendance rate 76% overall, 21% of students are below 70% attendance
- White Ribbon Week celebrated assemblies, skate across the state
- Academic Update, Amy Vance
  - MOY testing complete for K-6 students
    - Reading BOY at or above benchmark 38%, MOY at or above 46%
    - Math students coming in 1 or 2 years behind. Dreambox chart shows students making a year's growth within 5 months in the program.
    - Board wondering if well below kids in math are still well below MOY.
      Looking to see individual results. CAU will show the number of
      students that have moved proficiency level by grade level to see
      progress.
  - MOY testing for 7-9 students on 1/22

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- CRE Development Update, Kristina Vliek
  - Advisory Council needs recruitment effort from board and CAU staff to fill
    council positions in tech, manufacturing, drone, heavy equipment, oil/gas.
     Please send Bonita and Kristina recommendations. An oil/gas member would be
    very helpful in driving the program with the technical knowledge needed to
    drive the program.
  - Pathway development: heavy equipment fall 2024, drone (can be added as capstone) spring 2025. Seeking oil & gas vendors to provide curriculum spring 2025. Bioscience awaiting feedback, further discussion to take place to solidify summary of options that were discussed. Materials to be reviewed with follow up meeting. Kelvyn liked core of initial plan.
  - CAU students to attend Jr. Achievement event in February to simulate real life experiences pertaining to careers and finances.

  - Financials will be reviewed during the February meeting.
  - Audit will submit financials once available, in contact with USBE they are not surprised with the needed extension, supplying auditor with all that they need. Should be able to submit once financials are in. USBE extension not granted, just turn in ASAP. The board asked if there are ramifications. There are not, other than possibly ending up on a list of late filers. Lessons: start audit earlier. Next year should go faster since auditor will have a baseline of our school.
