## 21<sup>ST</sup> ANNUAL ANTELOPE BY MOONLIGHT BIKE RIDE "Shoot For The Moon"

### FARMINGTON, UT

Let's have some fun this summer! Bring your family and friends to the 21<sup>st</sup> annual Antelope by Moonlight Bike Ride on July 11<sup>th</sup> at 10 pm. This is a non-competitive, family friendly event held by the light of a full-moon on Antelope Island. The ride is 24 miles on an asphalt road. Come early to have a tailgate party with music from our locally famous Endless Summer Band and enjoy our vendors (applications now being taken). Prizes are offered for the best decorated bike or rider focusing on the theme- *Shoot For The Moon*. Judging will be at 9:00 pm on the main stage at White Rock Bay. Note this earlier time for judging.

Twelve miles down the east side road is the historic Fielding Garr Ranch where refreshments will be served until midnight.

Registration for the bike ride is on-line at [www.AntelopebyMoonlight.com](http://www.AntelopebyMoonlight.com) Early registration includes a Collector's T-shirt and is \$25 per person until July 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:59 pm. Late registration (Collector's T-shirt not guaranteed) is \$30 per person until July 9<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 pm. To allow staff to prepare for the ride, on-line registration will only be available through 11:59 pm on July 9<sup>th</sup>. Registration includes a Collector's t-shirt (early registrations), park entry, and refreshments (served at the Ranch until midnight).

As a reminder, we require riders to use a working headlight and taillight. Helmets are mandatory also. Lights and helmets will be available for sale at the ride. We ask riders to follow rules of the road and keep to the right.

Proceeds from this event go to Friends of Antelope Island, a 501c3 non-profit group that raises money for projects that 'enhance the visitor experience' on Antelope Island.
