Josh Daniels, Utah County Clerk/Auditor – Stated that the information statistics are not part of the official canvass report. They will be updated slightly because the final update was just barely done. It will be available on the website as well as on the State Elections website. Josh stated that the commission will be signing a declaration that declares elected those persons in the report that are within the board's jurisdiction. Stated that it takes about 54-man hours to process 10,000 ballots. Approximately 75,000 votes were cast in the last 24 hours of the election.

Josh Daniels, Paul Jones (Utah County Attorney), Cindy Butler (Statistician) and Commissioners discuss items such as school district boundary changes, when a recount is required (when the votes are within $\frac{3}{4}$ of 1%), the process of what happens to damaged ballots, Cast Vote Records, trends, data verification, precinct splits, election/data machines, signature verification, etc.

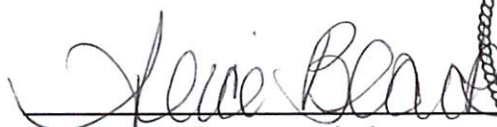
