PRIMARY ELECTION  
Tuesday, June 25, 2024**

I, Brian McKenzie, Davis County Clerk, hereby give notice of the Primary Election that will be held on Tuesday, June 25, 2024.

Voters must be citizens of the United States; residents of the voting precinct in which they are voting; and 18 years old, or older by the General Election in order to participate. All eligible voters will receive their ballot by mail approximately three weeks prior to Election Day.

Depending on your voting precinct, your ballot will contain the races listed on the sample ballot.

Accessible voting machines are available. Ballot Drop Boxes are available at all of these locations and are available 24/7 until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Early Voting will be held at the Davis County Administration Building June 18th through June 21st, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A drop box is also available at this location.

A pre-election test and audit will be conducted to verify the voting devices and tabulation equipment being used for the election will accurately count votes cast for all offices and measures. Anyone desiring to witness the testing is invited to attend, beginning at 10:00 a.m. May 31st at the Davis County Administration Building Room #202.

A post election audit will be conducted on July 3, 2024 starting at 10:00 a.m. Anyone desiring to witness the audit is invited to attend. The audit will be conducted at the Davis County Administration Building in Room # 202.

An individual with a disability who is not able to vote a manual (paper) ballot by mail, may obtain information on voting in an accessible manner by contacting the County Clerk.
