- Public Hearing: Ordinance #1596, an Ordinance amending the Official Zoning Map of Draper City for approximately 0.48 acres of property from RA2 (Residential Agricultural, 20,000 square foot minimum lot size) to CC (Community Commercial) located at approximately 11853 South 700 East, otherwise known as the Tunbridge Zoning Map

# Amendment. Continued from the December 6, 2023 City Council meeting.

Tevai Haunga, a city planner, showed maps of the subject area and explained the applicant's request to rezone from RA2 to CC to make the property easier to sell. She said the Planning Commission reviewed the application and forwarded a positive recommendation.

Kim Tunbridge, the applicant, said her husband applied for the rezone in 2023 and had since passed away. She said she did not have plans for the property at that time.

Mayor Walker opened a public hearing, and closed the public hearing seeing no one come forward.

Responding to a question from the Council, Community Development Director Jen Jastremsky said RA2 and CC Zones had different setback standards.

Councilmember T. Lowery moved to approve Ordinance #1596. Councilmember Roberts seconded the motion.

5.b Public Hearing: Ordinances #1605 and #1606, an Ordinance amending Official Land Use Map and Zoning Map of Draper City for approximately 1.19 acres from Community Commercial to Neighborhood Commercial and from RA1 (Residential Agricultural, 40,000 square foot minimum lot size) to CN (Neighborhood Commercial), located at approximately 11743 South 700 East within Draper City, otherwise known at the Federal Heights Holdings LLC Zoning and Land Use Amendments.

Maryann Pickering, a city planner, showed maps of the subject area and said the applicant proposed to change both the Land Use designation and Zoning Map for the property. If approved, the applicant may improve the property to commercial standards to operate a business. The Planning Commission forwarded a unanimous positive recommendation.

Marlin Bates, attorney for the applicant, said the applicant did not have plans for the property, but believed the requested changes would increase the value.

#### Mayor Walker opened a public hearing.

LaVar Christensen, Draper resident and owner of an office building across the street from the subject property said he appreciated the way 700 East had evolved. He expressed the opinion that the requested changes would blend well.

Mayor Walker closed the public hearing.

Councilmember F. Lowry moved to approve Ordinances #1605 and #1606. Councilmember Roberts seconded the motion.

Community Development Director Jennifer Jastremsky explained existing setbacks for the Rasmussen Family Subdivision and described proposed setbacks for oddly-shaped Lot 20.

5.d Action Item: Resolution #24-02, a Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign a real estate purchase agreement for the purchase of parcel #28-33-203-007 and parcel #28-33-203-010 located at approximately 12695 South 1700 East consisting of approximately 10.87 acres.

City Manager David Dobbins explained the proposal to purchase approximately 10 acres from the Canyons School District, with the intention to pursue the option of using five acres for cemetery space and selling the other half for single-family home development. The cemetery portion of the purchase would be paid out of the General Fund. Mr. Dobbins presented three amendments to the real estate purchase agreement requested by the School District.

Councilmember F. Lowry moved to approve Resolution #24-02, subject to the following amendments: the City would equally share in any proceeds above the purchase price, the disclosure deadlines changed to April 1, 2024, and the settlement date to April 30, 2024, and the acceptance date changed to March 15, 2024. Councilmember Roberts seconded the motion.



- Liquor liability insurance.
- Bond payable to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Services.
- Floor map showing where alcohol is to be served, stored, and consumed.
- Sales tax license.
- A background check conducted by the Bureau of Criminal Identification.

Douang Investments LLC dba Tuk Tuk's has also applied for and is in the process of obtaining a Draper City business license for their restaurant operations.

#### The findings for Local Consent approval are as follows:

DCMC 6-4-040 requires that a limited-service restaurant be at least three hundred feet (300') away from any community location (schools, churches, public libraries, public playgrounds, and public parks) measured by the shortest pedestrian route taken from the nearest patron entrance of the restaurant to the property boundary of the community location.

Douang Investments LLC dba Tuk Tuk's has met this requirement.

DCMC 6-4-040 requires that a limited-service restaurant be at least two hundred feet (200') away from any community location (schools, churches, public libraries, public playgrounds, and public parks) measured in a straight line from the nearest patron entrance of the restaurant to the property boundary of the community location.

Douang Investments LLC dba Tuk Tuk's has met this requirement.

DCMC 6-4-050 places no restrictions on the number of full-service restaurant licenses that can be granted by the City.





Fleet Equipment and Site improvements for Solid Waste Facility New CIP Fleet will need new lifts and tools to run a second crew at the new solid waste facility. The current site will also need some modifications to allow for parking of the solid waste equipment and fleet repairs inside the bays. Total cost for the equipment and the required modifications are budgeted at \$300,000.

Rotary Disc Golf Course CIP 24-08 Parks and Rec is requesting an increase to the budget for the Rotary Disc Golf Course. The project currently has a budget of \$100,000 (\$50,000 to be reimbursed from the Utah Outdoor Recreation Grant). A bid alternate to provide a waterline connection and a permanent irrigation system was included in the landscaping bid. An additional \$30,000 is needed to install this system, which will save on the ongoing labor costs to hand water the landscaping, and provide a lower mortality rate of the plantings. Completion of the waterline would also allow the extension of the irrigation system to future tree plantings and the installation of a future drinking fountain along the trail.

Draper Park -South Parking Lot Expansion CIP 24-09 Parks and Rec is requesting an The project was originally budgeted with \$350,000 from Park Impact Fees, which covered the cost for only a portion of the planned parking lot. An additional \$275,000 is needed to construct the entire planned parking lot and to install a precast concrete wall along the south property line.

114 South Culvert Replacement New CIP The East Jordan Canal culvert crossing 11400 South needs to be replaced. Draper City and Sandy City have an equal share of the maintenance responsibility for the culvert as 11400 South is the municipal boundary line between the two cities. Federal funding has been approved for this culvert replacement, which requires a 6.77% financial match of the total cost of the project. The match will be split between the two local agencies. Draper City's share of the cost, based upon the current cost estimate, is \$101,550. Upon local agency approval, the environmental and design work will begin for this project.

Fund Balance – General Fund \$ 125,000

Capital Projects \$ 125,000
