- 1. Pledge of Allegiance- The pledge of allegiance was said.
- 2. Prayer/Invocation/Reading/Thought- Doug Jewell gave the opening invocation.
- **3. Minutes-** The Minutes of February 21, 2024, were emailed to the Council before the meeting. Doug made a motion to approve the Minutes, Whit seconded that motion. All in favor.

  - Fire/Grants- Doug Jewell- The Fire Department applied for a FEMA Grant. They are hoping to hear back within the next few weeks. Ashley is free and has time to get sworn-in on Thursday March 21, 2024, 6:00 p.m. That would be right before the Paradise Irrigation meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup>, which will start at 7:00 p.m. The Council doesn't think it will take long for the swear-in. Doug will be working with the Fire Department on getting a complete proposed budget for next year.
