1. **Pledge of Allegiance-** The pledge of allegiance was said.
2. **Prayer/Invocation/Reading/Thought-** Doug Jewell gave the opening invocation.
3. **Minutes-** The Minutes of February 21, 2024, were emailed to the Council before the meeting. Doug made a motion to approve the Minutes, Whit seconded that motion. All in favor.
4. **Bills-** Whit read the bills. Doug made a motion to approve the bills, Whit seconded that motion, all in favor.
5. **Public Comment-** Nothing at this time.
6. **Purchase Requests –** None at this time.
7. **Cemetery Sprinkler System-** The Cemetery district is ready to move onto the next sprinkler system phase, Phase 3. The bid received from Ideal Landscape was \$14,800.00. It was split into 3 categories: Trenching-\$1300.00, Sprinkler installation- \$1,500.00, and Parts-\$9,000.00.
8. **Unfinished Business-**

The Fire Chief went to the emergency preparedness meeting in Hyrum and reported back to Doug. There was a discussion on green waste and how to bill all of Paradise/Avon area and if that was a possibility.
9. **New Business-** Nothing at this time.
10. **Council Reports-**
 - **Roads- Devin Thomas-** Jeremy Hudson with the County reached out to see what roads would need chip-sealed this year. Lee and Devin will go over which roads need to be sealed and get back to Jeremy.
 - **Water-Whit Gale-** The paperwork for the spring property is with Mike Olsen with Coldwater Ranch waiting on his signature, once he signs it, he will send it back to us.
 - **Community- Steve Gibbs-** Steve reported on the Youth Council and asked the Councils advice on how to meet. Steve would like to get them together once a month and get some plans in place.
 - **Fire/Grants- Doug Jewell-** The Fire Department applied for a FEMA Grant. They are hoping to hear back within the next few weeks. Ashley is free and has time to get sworn-in on Thursday March 21, 2024, 6:00 p.m. That would be right before the Paradise Irrigation meeting on the 21st, which will start at 7:00 p.m. The Council doesn't think it will take long for the swear-in. Doug will be working with the Fire Department on getting a complete proposed budget for next year.
11. **Adjourn-** Doug made a motion to adjourn, Whit seconded that motion. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:51 p.m.
