APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

Mrs. Rasmussen moved to approve the listed meeting minutes. **Mr. St. Jacques seconded** the motion. Those voting aye: Shirlene Rasmussen, Mike MacKay, Robert St. Jacques, and Casey Anderson. **The motion passed** unanimously.

APPEARANCES

Heidi Hodgson – Fairview Farmers Market

Heidi Hodgson appeared before the Council and presented a report detailing statistics and the success which the Farmer’s Market had during 2023. She thanked the Council for the support they offered and expressed how she felt the Farmer’s Market could further succeed next year. Ms. Hodgson then asked the Council for a \$500 sponsorship.

The City Council unanimously agreed to sponsor the farmers market again.

Tim Bingham – Fairview City History Events

Mr. Bingham appeared before the Council and presented an idea he has for an event aiming to gather, digitize, and distribute historical city documents. He asked the City Council if this event could be hosted in the dance hall.

The Council instructed Mr. Bingham to keep in touch with city employees and also suggested reaching out to Fairview Museum workers.

Water and Sewer Department Updates

Mr. Jackson appeared before the Council and presented the Fairview City 2023 Annual Water Report. He went over water connections, water usage, source inventory, and loss. He then detailed water main breaks and upcoming water projects.

Mr. Jackson concluded his presentation by proposing a new location for the public limb dumping location. The proposed location would be situated just north of the cemetery. This location would be at a lower elevation and inset into the hill so as not to be an eyesore for cemetery visitors.

Mr. MacKay motioned to approve the new limb-dump location. **Mr. St. Jacques** seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Senior Center Rental Rates

The City Council discussed rental rates for the newly acquired senior citizen's center. They decided the daily rental rates would be 100 dollars for residents and 150 dollars for non-residents. A security deposit of \$200 will be required all.
