<u>ERDA, UTAH</u> ORDINANCE NO.24 -04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAND USE CODE TABLE 15-5-3.2 TO MAKE HOME -BASED BUSINESS AS A CONDITIONAL USE IN THE RR-5 ZONING DISTRICT AND AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF HOME BASED BUSINESS

WHEREAS, the Erda City Council ("Council") met in regular session on March 28, 2024 to consider among other things, amending the Land Use Code Table 15-5-3.2 to make home-based business as a conditional use in the RR-5 zoning district and amending the definition of Home-Based Business; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. § 10-9a-503 provides in part that the Council may amend any regulations of a zoning district; and

WHEREAS, Erda City ("City") has adopted a comprehensive zoning ordinance ("Zoning Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Ann. § 10-9a-502 provides planning commission shall provide notice as required by Subsection 10-9a-205(1)(a) and, if applicable, Subsection 10-9a-205(4) and hold a public hearing on the proposed land use ordinances; and

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2023 the required notice was published; and

WHEREAS, on October 10th, 2023 the proposed amendment was submitted to the planning commission for its recommendation; and

WHEREAS, on October 10th, 2023 the planning commission held the required public hearing with respect to the amendment; and

WHEREAS, at the November 10th, 2023 planning commission meeting the Erda Planning Commission recommended not to approve the amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Erda Code of Ordinances and Utah Code, provides among other things, that before finally passing the Amendment, the Council shall consider the application during a public meeting which has been properly noticed in compliance with the provisions of Title 52, Chapter 4, of the Open and Public Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, on November 29, 2023, the Council caused the required notice to be given; and

WHEREAS, on December 28th, 2023, the Council considered the amendment and remanded it to the Planning Commission for further consideration;

WHEREAS, at the February 13th, 2024 planning commission reviewed the remanded ordinance and recommended additional amendment ("Amendment").

WHEREAS, on February 22nd, 2024, the Council considered the amendment and remanded it to the Planning Commission for further consideration;

WHEREAS, at the March 12th, 2024 planning commission reviewed the remanded ordinance and recommended additional amendment ("Amendment") and recommended to approve.

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council that the Amendment be adopted (designated by interlineating the words to be deleted and underlining the words to be added) as attached.

This Ordinance assigned Ordinance No. 24-04, shall take effect as soon as it shall be published or posted as required by law, deposited, and recorded in the office of the City Recorder, and accepted as required herein.
