

CANVASS OF ELECTION MINUTES

March 18, 2024

Minutes of the Canvass of Election meeting of the Sevier County Commissioners held this eighteenth day of March 2024. Meeting commenced at 11:10 a.m. with Commissioners Scott Johnson, Greg Jensen, and Ralph Brown in the Commission Chambers of the Sevier County Administration Building, 250 North Main, Richfield, Utah. Clerk/Auditor Steven Wall, Deputy Clerk/Auditor Barbara Crowther, and Executive Director Malcolm Nash were also present.

Barbara Crowther reviewed the number of ballots mailed, and the number of active registered voters as of the Wednesday prior to Election Day for the 2024 Presidential Primary Election. She noted the number of ballots audited during the election process as required by the State of Utah. She also reviewed the results of the election noting how many ballots were returned eligible to be counted, the number of Uniformed and Overseas ballots, as well as the number of ballots that were not cured and could not be counted, and that there were no provisional ballots. She said that Commissioner Johnson had participated with the ballot audit. After discussion, Commissioner Brown moved to declare the results as official, approve the 2024 Presidential Primary Election Canvass, and thank the Clerk/Auditor's Office for the work they have done on the election, second Commissioner Jensen, unanimous.

There being no further business to come before the Board, meeting adjourned at 11:13 a.m.
