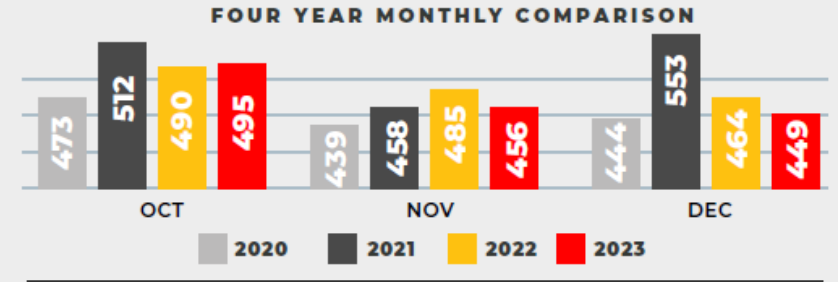

Current Updates

- FY 24/25 Budget:
 - All UFA Divisions are working through proposed budgets for next FY
 - Some priorities for the year:
 - wages and benefits
 - reducing vacancies
 - employee health and wellness programs

- Fire Station 102 Completion (Magna)
 - Crews moved into the new station on Jan. 4





Current Updates

- Fire Station 112 Seismic Retrofit
 - All permits have been approved by Millcreek to get the seismic retrofit of Station 112 underway
 - Additional requirements are necessary due to the stations' location in an alluvial floodplain
 - This project is focused on a “collapse prevention” approach to the retrofit vs. “immediate occupancy” to ensure we gain the greatest value from the limited budget available





Current Updates

- Winter Safety Message
 - We see more residential home fires in winter than any other season
 - Be sure to test smoke detectors
 - Install Carbon Monoxide detectors in your home
 - Plan two ways to get out of your home quickly in the event of an emergency
 - Have a pre-planned outdoor family meeting place
 - In the event of a power outage generators should only be used outdoors, not in a garage
 - If heat stops working and a portable heater is necessary, keep it at least 3' from combustibles and turn it off when sleeping
