2024 Grant Program

- Similar process to previous years
- Approximately \$500,000 to distribute
- Response
 - * 51 applications
 - * Over \$1.3 million requested
- Applications reviewed and evaluated by 18 working group members
- March 8: Working group developed recommendation list to forward to UBJJ
- March 21: UBJJ reviewed and approved recommendation list to forward to CCJJ



UBJJ allocates Title II Federal funding, through a competitive grant process, to eligible entities across Utah to support programs and services for juveniles involved with the juvenile justice system and juveniles at-risk of such involvement, as well as their parents/guardians and families.
