Jon Maxwell: Business of the Quarter Mayor and Council reviewed the previous business of the quarter. **Mayor Maxwell** asked if the council had any ideas. The Mayor and Council chose Wheeler's Machinery for business of the quarter and NAPA Auto Parts next quarter.


Kevin Mickelsen: Discuss Street Sweeper **Jorgen Mickelson** presented a bid for a used 2014 Autocar Xpert Street Sweeper in the amount of \$69,950. **Randy Christiansen** asked if it would be utilized on all the streets in town. **Mickelson** stated this can help with keeping the gutters clean as well. **Mayor Maxwell** stated Salina City received a grant to sweep Main Street, around NSMS and 200 north for the Balloon Festival and the cost for those few streets was approximately \$8,000. Mayor and Council discussed the pros and cons of purchasing a street sweeper. **Allen Tietjen** motioned to approve purchasing the street sweeper in the amount of \$69,950. **Earl Taylor** seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.

Randy Christiansen: Approval of February court report 2024 **Randy Christiansen** motioned to approve the February Court Report 2024 total taken in \$2,372.26 Salina City portion \$2,007.19 **Earl Taylor** seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.

Allen Tietjen asked if Joe Parker was continuing to help with weed control. Mayor Maxwell stated yes, he should continue to help Salina City every year. **Kathy Maxwell** said she will contact Joe and see if he is still interested in helping Salina City.

Allen Tietjen: Discuss Town-clean-up/Service projects **Allen Tietjen** presented a list of service projects in town he would like to get a group together to help paint curbs, fire hydrants and the entry signs, weed control in town, clean the freeway entrance, clean the rodeo grounds, help with the cemeteries before Memorial Day, tree trimming next to the bike path. Tietjen asked if Mayor and Council have any other ideas. **Mayor Maxwell** stated this looks like a great start. **Randy Christiansen** suggested watering the flower on Main Street.

Earl Taylor motioned to adjourn the City Council at 7:45 p.m. **Jon Maxwell** seconded. Motion carried 4 to 0.
