23 application.

24 Councilor Darcey has put together a budget for Fiesta Days and distributed a copy for the  
25 council to review.

26 The City Council reviewed and discussed the budget.

28 Steve Mitchell stated he would like to use the marketing money and advertise on Z104  
29 KSOP radio to promote the rodeos. The council liked the idea and would like to move  
30 forward with it.

31 Steve Mitchell stated the theme for Fiesta Days this year will be “Growing up in a small  
32 town”. Mitchell has asked Terry and Vickie Atkinson to be our Grand Marshall’s.

33 Mitchell is looking for someone to sponsor Kid’s Night but hasn’t had any success. He  
34 has put in a call to Zion’s Bank but hasn’t heard back.

35 Mayor McCormick suggested having Kamas City sponsor Kid’s Night. The council  
36 agrees. Mitchell will wait to hear back from Zion’s before a decision is made.

37 Mitchell asked if we can have a Fiesta Days work session to iron out final details.

38 Mayor McCormick told him we could do it at our next meeting, but Kerbee isn’t able to  
39 attend on Tuesday’s. We will figure out a day everyone can be there and get it scheduled.

41 Councilor Darcey stated he will be turning in the grant application on Friday. If anyone  
42 has questions about the budget, please call him before then.
