Salt Lake County Parks and Recreation will be holding a 30-45 minute Ribbon Cutting Ceremony at Wrangler Trailhead to highlight the completion of the projects from the 2017 ZAP funds.

Dignitaries will speak and then they will be taken to see the completed parking and bathroom at [Badger Cove \(1700 E. 10600 S\)](#) and then up the street to [2765 E. Dimple Dell Road](#) to see the year round bathroom and improvements.

South East portion of park-, to include Centennial Trail, Fire Suppression Pond, Sunflower Meadow, stream bed, Dry Creek Trail, Pump House Trail and restored amphitheater area.

3) 2940 E. Mount Jordan Road -Tree Planting at Historic Muir Poulsen Orchard

20 apricot trees, Under the direction of Tree Utah and Heather and Zach Dupaix. 20 apple trees were planted last fall. **Begins at 12:00 noon.**

Lots of Russian Thistle to remove, reseeding going East and Westward along the North Rim Trail and property fence lines.

High School LaCross team Chase, Coby and Chip Broyles, Dalton and sons.

Emergency Crews will be present at Wrangler Trailhead as well as display tables by
Sage Fitch, County Weeds and Bees and Ian William of Sandy City Animal Control

8) Trash tree and wood cutting for Fire Remediation South West of 1300 E tunnel.
Sandy City Firemen will be cutters and swamper. Direction of Lisa and Will Caddy.
20 people from Security Federal Credit Union and the Back Country Horsemen.
Wood will later be chipped by the Dimple Dell Parks crew.

WHEN: Saturday April 27th, 12:00pm—4:00pm

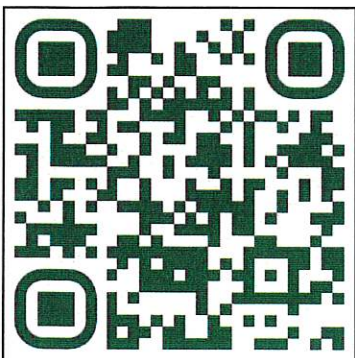
Join us April 27th as we plant 20 new fruit trees in the 2nd phase of this historic endeavor.
