3 Health Resource Fairs were held at our Senior Activity Centers



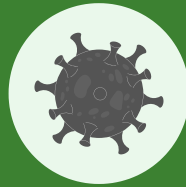
3 combined Senior Center Activities were held throughout 2023



Partnered with the University of Utah to conduct a malnutrition study, which provides a Registered Dietician to conduct nutritional screenings



24 homebound study participants received 250.5 hours of nutritional counseling



COVID-19 Efforts



SWOT Analysis identified Division strengths and areas for improvement during the COVID-19 pandemic



Partnered with Davis Behavioral Health to have a mental health professional visit the Senior Activity Centers every month in 2023



USAgging grant provided over 250 vaccines in homes and nearly 400 in Senior Activity Centers



362 individuals participated in healthy aging evidence-based classes

53 Senior Activity Center individuals participated in 14 Music Therapy classes held at the Centers

\$200k of local funding was received to help support The Alternatives Program



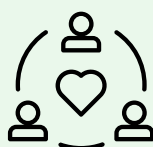

Caregiving Efforts



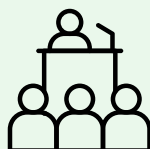
10 caregiver classes were hosted throughout 2023

Over 100 caregivers received services in 2023



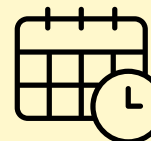
Hosted the Caregiver Conference in partnership with the Utah Geriatric Education Consortium



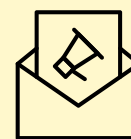
Elder Justice
