A. Minute Approval

B.1. Jan Minutes: Marlene Teter approved, Laura Gaillard seconded, none opposed.

C. New Business:

C.1. New Arts Council Members Intro- We have two new arts council members- Elizabeth Davis and Shan Lloyd that both joined us and introduced themselves to the group.

C.2. Chair/Co-chair 2024 vote- Laura Gaillard was appointed Chair and Jason Yeaman was appointed Co-chair. Elizabeth approved and Shan seconded, none opposed.

C.3. Art Swap- Scheduled for Saturday Feb 24- Arts Council members were asked to register or confirm that they will attend the Art Swap by February 17, so we have an accurate head count for the event. We talked about this event and if it should be open to the public. After some discussion about logistics, we decided that we would run it as is with registered artists and their plus one and it is not open to the public otherwise.

C.4. SoJo Summerfest Music poster, Vote- We had the top five entries at the meeting to choose the winner, 1st runner up and 2nd runner up. Chrissey Hayes won the contest, Erin Grimshaw was the 1st runner up and Jordan Halliday was the 2nd runner up. The vote was motioned by Laura and Rachel seconded, none opposed.

C.5. Janell- Art Projects flow-chart/check list in Arts Master Plan – Janell pulled up the Arts Master Plan and we coved the flow chart of how new artwork will be approved and moved through the City. We will start using the flow chart for all new projects as of now. We have also implemented a check off list for the Arts Master Plan on the City staff side of Basecamp.

C.6. Janell- Trax update- Janell gave an update on some of the ideas that Trax have mentioned for the new station in DayBreak. Janell asked Arts Council if they were interested in adding art to the station and how much funds they would be will to put toward it. We looked at the budget for next year and felt as a group between some of the public art budget and part of the wrap budget, we felt comfortable putting \$15,000 towards a piece of art at the Trax station. We did talk about the idea of collaborating with DayBreak if they were interested in this project as well. We felt like we could come up with a project that had glass with a transparent art wrap on the glass. Janell will continue to work with Trax and we will see what is possible.

C.7. Art Show- open for registration until March 4 (or until full)- As of right now we have 76 entries for the Art Show. We can fit about 120 total.
