Subject: 2023-2024 Short-Term Projects Funding

Commissioners,

The Short-Term Projects Committee convened on Monday, April 15th in Cottonwood Heights to review the pool of finalist project proposals submitted to the Central Wasatch Commission during the call for ideas, which was open March 4th, 2024 – March 25th, 2024.

The Committee is chaired by Mayor Mike Weichers with membership from Mayor Monica Zoltanski, Mayor Roger Bourke, Commissioner Annalee Munsey, and Commissioner Dave Whittekiend. Together, they considered how to disperse the \$95,000 available in the 2023-2024 fiscal year budget for projects.

The Committee reviewed 14 proposals totaling \$207,500 in requested funds, and <u>recommends allocation</u>, in full <u>or in part</u>, for the following 12 projects:

Total Budget: \$95,000

Total Recommended Funding: \$117,800

Given the substantial surplus in the CWC's budget this fiscal year, the Short-Term Projects Committee requests allocating **an additional \$22,800** to Short-Term Projects to account for the proposed funding recommendations, on top of the already budgeted \$95,000.

These projects have either been previously funded by the Central Wasatch Commission, or have been reviewed by the Forest Service and found to be eligible and feasible if taking place on Forest Service land.

Next year, the Short-Term Projects Grant cycle timeline will shift to accommodate a request from the Salt Lake Ranger District that will give them more time to effectively review proposals. The call will open on January 6, 2025 and close on February 18, 2025. Funding decisions will be made at the June Board meeting.
