APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

- February 15, 2024, Meeting Minutes

Mr. St. Jacques moved to approve the minutes. **Mr. MacKay Seconded** the motion. Those voting aye: Shirlene Rasmussen, Mike MacKay, Robert St. Jacques, and Casey Anderson. **The motion passed** unanimously.

APPEARANCES

Hilary Thompson – YLA Senior Center Usage

Hilary Thompson appeared before the Council and asked to use the Senior Citizens Center for hosting a home school organization on Wednesday mornings throughout March and April. She stated in exchange for allowing this usage, the organization would help to beautify the grounds.

Mr. MacKay expressed concern for the loss of potential income. Ms. Thompson responded they hope to exceed the potential rental cost with their in-kind labor. Mr. MacKay suggested requiring a security deposit for the group.

Mr. MacKay moved to allow the requested usage with the understanding they will pay the rental fee back in-kind and put down a security deposit. **Mr. Anderson seconded** the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Miss Fairview Introductions

The 2024 Miss Fairview Royalty introduced themselves to the City Council. They expressed how willing they are to help and serve in the community. They asked the Council for \$300 to help repair the Miss Fairview Parade Float. The Council approved their request.

Cade Penny – Six County Community Advisory

Mr. Penny introduced himself and the Community Advisor Program which Six County hosts. He then announced that Six County is changing their organization name to R6 Regional Council. Mr. Penny concluded his presentation by informing the Council about CIB grant funding.

REPORT / ACTION ITEMS

Power Department Updates

Fairview City Power Department Superintendent Greg Sorensen updated the Council on a 1.9 million dollar grant they recently received to overhaul one of the city's longest power lines. He then went over outages and asked the Council to investigate raising power impact fees.

General discussion ensued regarding part supply and upcoming projects.

Power Rate / Utilization Study

Mr. Anderson asked the Council if they wanted to do an in-depth utility rate study. The Council agreed to pay extra money to hold the in-depth over a baseline study which would just cover the power rates.

Mr. Anderson motioned to hold an in-depth utility rate study. **Shirlene seconded**. The motion passed unanimously.

Spring Cleanup Date

The Council tabled this item until the next regularly scheduled meeting.

City Hall Drainage / Maintenance

Ms. Rasmussen stated part of the city hall basement floods during heavy rain because of the lack of awning over the north stairwell. She also explained how other drains on the property get backed up because they aren't cleaned out regularly.

The City Council instructed city staff to clean out City Hall drains on a regular basis and to get bids on putting an awning over the stairwell on the north end of the building.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL REPORTS

The City Council updated each other and residents on upcoming activities and other general administrative items.

Mayor Welch assigned Bob St. Jacques to be over the economic development and roads departments. He then assigned Mr. Cheney to oversee the recreation and power department.

APPROVAL OF VOUCHERS

Mr. Anderson motioned to approve the vouchers. **Ms. Rasmussen seconded** the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT

Ms. Rasmussen moved to adjourn the meeting. Those voting aye: Shirlene Rasmussen, Mike MacKay, Robert St. Jacques, and Casey Anderson. **The motion passed** unanimously.
