Spencer House and Liberty Park

Robyn MacDuff

Robyn MacDuff shared a PowerPoint presentation about Liberty Park, Wheeler Farm, and the Spencer Homestead. The presentation included photos of the different maintenance facilities from all the stated parks.

Patrick Leary explained the purpose of a master plan and discussed the need for a maintenance facility in Dimple Dell Park.

Patrick Leary urged Dimple Dell Advisory Board to articulate their values and considerations for the location, such as avoiding neighborhoods and historic areas, and prioritizing convenience and efficiency for maintenance work.

Nikki Wyman is going to create a google doc as a launch point for Board members to share values and ideas for the maintenance facility.

Emily Montgomery mentioned there was confusion and concern about the lack of communication regarding the master planning process and open house meetings. Patrick Leary will share her concerns with his team at Salt Lake County.
