 - Enrollment 265 Students, 57% MS/HS, 16% SE, 4% 504, 2% EL
 - Goal 1 Cameras 95% On Elementary Baseline – 85% January 11, 2024 – 96% February 20, 2024 – 96%
 Secondary Baseline – 25% January 11, 2024 – 95% February 20, 2024 - 91% *
 - Goal 2 Math Class Attendance below goals
 - Goal 3 LOPT Average 62% scoring 80% or above, 50% scoring 80% or above. MS/HS teachers and SE teachers finding difficulty in hitting goals

- Goal 4 teachers will deliver 3 consecutive lessons with 80% or higher.

 - Created an observation schedule. Administration is in 80% of the classroom daily. Observers are in all math classes daily.
 - · All observers are using LOPT instrument during observations.
 - Coaching Support: Short cycle feedback is being provided to teachers during these sessions

Elementary March 10, 2024 - 81%

Secondary March 10, 2024 - 70%

- CRE Development Update, Kristina Vliek
 - CTE courses must be USBE approved. Funding provided upon approved pathways. Courses/pathways that are not USBE approved need to go through regional approval process prior to being used. Regional approval process requires heavy industry and post-secondary involvement and takes 2-3 years to complete.
